Polar Fleece Tree Pillows

Shopping List:

- HUSQVARNA VIKING TOPAZ™ 30 sewing and embroidery machine
- 2/3 Yard embroidered or plain polar fleece (will make 2 pillows)
- Roller Foot
- Edge/Quilting Guide
- Sewing thread

Polar Fleece Tree Pillow – Sewing Instructions:

We embroidered stars from Stars1 in the Shapes Tab in Husqvarna Viking 4D Embroidery Software

Sew:

1. Create pattern pieces following the diagram given. See Illustration A. Cut out the four pattern pieces from the polar fleece.
2. Snap on your Roller Foot. Thread with sewing thread top and bobbin. Select a straight stitch, center needle position. Attach your Edge/Quilting Guide and set it 1" from the needle. Stitch piece #1 to piece #2, with wrong sides together, using a 1" seam allowance.
3. Stitch piece #1/#2 to piece #3, with wrong sides together, using a 1" seam allowance. This should now look like piece #4, a triangle shape.
4. Place your pieced triangle on top of piece #4, wrong sides together. (Remember the wrong side of the pieced triangle is the smooth side.) Using the same 1" seam allowance, stitch around the triangle, leaving about a 5" opening at the bottom.
5. Stuff the pillow with fiber fill to desired fullness.
6. Stitch 5" opening closed.
7. Fringe all of the 1" seams with scissors. Simply snip toward the stitching, approximately 1/4" apart. Enjoy!
